The Lewisham (Charged-For Parking Places) (Amendment No. 44) Order 2022

The Lewisham (Free Parking Places, Loading Places and Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions)

(Amendment No. 39) Order 2022

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lewisham Borough Council on 4th March 2022 made the abovementioned Orders under the powers of sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

2. The general effect of the Orders will be to provide a new ‘short stay’ disabled blue badge holder’s parking place in the north-east side of Courthill Road, 6.6 metres in length, extending north-westward from a point 5.5 metres north-west of the north-western wall of No. 1 Courthill Road, removing an existing limited waiting place and ‘single yellow line’ at this location. Vehicles displaying a valid disabled persons blue badge may be left in the new parking place for a maximum stay of up to 20 minutes at any time, provided no vehicle may return within 2 hours.

4. If any person wishes to question the validity of the Orders or of any of their provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under that Act has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Orders were made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
