FRANCEMARY ROAD AND OLDSTEAD ROAD INTRODUCTION OF AT DISABLED PERSONS PARKING PLACES

The Lewisham (Charged-For Parking Places) (Amendment No. *) Order 202*

The Lewisham (Free Parking Places, Loading Places and Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions) (Amendment No. *) Order 202*

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lewisham Borough Council propose to make the above-mentioned Orders under the powers of sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

2. The general effect of the Orders would be to introduce disabled parking places in;

(a) **Francemary Road:** south west side from a point 3.85 metres south east of the common boundary of Nos. 26 and 28 south-eastwards for 6.6 metres;

(b) **Oldfield Road:** south side from a point 0.75 metres east of the common boundary of Nos. 104 and 106 Oldfield Road to the common boundary of Nos. 106 and 108 Oldfield Road.

3. A pack of documents giving more detailed particulars of the Order can be collected for inspection between 9 am and 5 pm on Monday to Friday at the office of the London Borough of Lewisham, Laurence House, 1 Catford Road, London SE6 4RU. Please go to the security office at the rear of the building and request a pack of documents for 'disabled parking batch 2 - TMO'. Any objection or other representations relating to the proposed Orders must be made in writing and all objections must specify the grounds on which they are made and must be emailed to: parkingdesign@lewisham.gov.uk or posted to Lewisham Transport Policy & Development, 5th Floor Laurence House, 1 Catford Road, London SE6 4RU, quoting reference 'disabled parking batch 2 - TMO' to arrive not later than 21 days from the date of publication of this notice. Any objection may be communicated to other persons who may be affected.
