ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A23 GLA ROAD AND GLA SIDE ROAD (BRIXTON HILL/ BRIXTON ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2022

1. Transport for London in consultation with the London Borough of Lambeth hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable highway improvement and resurfacing works to take place on the A23 Brixton Hill/Brixton Road.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 - (1) entering, exiting or proceeding on Brixton Hill southbound between its junctions with Coldharbour Lane/ Arce Lane/ Effra Road and St Matthew's Road;
 - (2) entering, exiting or proceeding on Brixton Road northbound between its junctions with Acre Lane and Stockwell Road;
 - (3) stopping on Brixton Road between its junctions with Arce Lane and Stockwell Road;
 - (4) entering, proceeding or stopping on Brighton Terrace eastbound between its junctions Bernay's Grove and Brixton Road.

The Order will also:

- (5) permit all vehicles to use the northbound and southbound bus lanes on Brixton Road between its junctions with Acre Lane and Stockwell Road;
- (6) permit two-way operation on Ferndale Road between its junctions with Brixton Road and Nursery Road.

Works will be phased such that some restrictions will apply only at certain times. Residential access will be maintained.

The Order will be effective at certain times between 12:01 am on 19th March 2022 and 14th May 2022 every night 9:00 PM to 6:00 AM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs. Northbound diversion via Streatham Place, Atkins Road, Poynders Road, Cavendish Road, Clapham Common South Side, The Avenue, Clapham Common South Side, Clapham High Street, Clapham Road, Kennington Park Road and Camberwell New Road to normal route of travel. Southbound diversion via Kennington Park Road, Clapham Road, Clapham High Street, Clapham Common South Side, Cavendish Road, Poynders Road, Atkins Road and Streatham Place to normal route of travel.
