ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A2 GLA SIDE ROAD (MINA ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2022

1. Transport for London in consultation with the London Borough of Southwark hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable building redevelopment works to take place on Mina Road.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 - (1) entering, exiting, proceeding or stopping on Mina Road between its junctions with Ivy Church Lane and Old Kent Road, except pedal cycles;
 - (2) entering or proceeding on Mina Road between its junctions with Bagshot Street and Ivy Church Lane, except for local access.The Order will be effective at certain times between 16th March 2022 and 16th June 2022 every Monday to Friday 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Albany Road and Bagshot Street or reverse to normal route of travel or via Kinglate Street and Bagshot Street to normal route of travel.
