ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A24 GLA ROAD (MORDEN ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF MERTON) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF STOPPING AND SUSPENSION OF BUS LANE) ORDER 2022

- Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above-named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable Thames Water works to take place on a section of the A24 Morden Road.
- The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 stopping between Nos. 250 and Nos. 178 Morden Road both directions:
 - The Order will also permit:
 - (2) all vehicles to use the Morden Road northbound bus lane between its junctions with Kenley Road and Dorset Road.
 - The Order will be effective from 8:00 AM on 4th April 2022 until 5:00 PM on 22nd April 2022 or when those works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
- (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
