ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A202 GLA ROAD AND THE A200 GLA SIDE ROAD (QUEEN'S ROAD AND SOUTHWARK PARK ROAD, LONDON BOROUGHS OF SOUTHWARK AND LEWISHAM) BANNED TURNS TRAFFIC ORDER 2022

THE A23 AND A202 GLA ROADS (STREATHAM HIGH ROAD AND QUEEN'S ROAD) (LONDON BOROUGHS OF LAMBETH AND LEWISHAM) BANNED U-TURNS TRAFFIC ORDER 2022

1. Transport for London, hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Orders under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
2. The general nature and effect of the Orders will be to formalise the existing on street controls banning all vehicles:
 - (1) except buses, pedal cycles and taxis from turning right from Southwark Park Road into the A200 Jamaica Road;
 - (2) from turning right from the A202 Queen's Road into Pomeroy Street;
 - (3) from turning right from the A202 Queen's Road into Lausanne Road;
 - (4) from making a U-Turn from the southbound carriageway of the A23 Streatham High Road at its junction with Norfolk house Road.
 - (5) from making a U-Turn from the westbound carriageway of the A202 Queen's Road at the western end of the central reservation at its junction with Kender Street.
3. The roads which would be affected by the Orders are Southwark Park Road, the A202 Queen's Road and the A23 Streatham High Road.
4.
