The alternative route for affected vehicles would be via: (a) Drewstead Road, Sternhold Avenue, Streatham High

Road, Becmead Avenue and Garrads Road; and (b) Garrads Road, Tooting Bec Road, Tooting Bec Gardens. Streatham High Road and Drewstead Road. 3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the

appropriate traffic signs. 4. The Order would come into force on 9th May 2022 and would continue for a maximum duration of 3 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the works would

be completed within 12 days, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during this time then the Order may have effect at a subsequent time within the maximum
