## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A2 GLA ROAD (BLACKHEATH ROAD, ROYAL BOROUGH OF GREENWICH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2022

- I. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above-named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.

  2. The purpose of the Order is to enable water main repair works to take place on Blackheath Road.
  - (1) turning right from Greenwich South Street into Blackheath Road westbound:

3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:

- (2) stopping on the northern kerb-line of Blackheath Road between Nos. 75 and 111.

  The Order will be effective at certain times between 8:00 AM on 30th
- April 2022 until 5:00 PM and 1st May 2022 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
  - brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
    (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police

(I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire

constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.

5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs via Blackheath Hill, Shooters Hill, Rochester

Way, Kidbrooke Park Road, Eltham Road, Lee High Road, Lee Bridge,

Lewisham High Street and Lewisham Road to normal route of travel.
