ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A3214 GLA ROAD (BUCKINGHAM PALACE ROAD, CITY OF WESTMINSTER) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2022

- I. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above-named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable frame and cover repair works to take place on the A3214 Buckingham Palace Road.3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 - (1) entering, exiting, or proceeding on Buckingham Palace Road northbound between its junctions with Elizabeth Street and Grosvenor Gardens;
 (2) entering or proceeding on Buckingham Palace Road porthbound
 - (2) entering or proceeding on Buckingham Palace Road northbound between its junctions with Pimlico Road and Elizabeth Street, except buses.

The Order will be effective at certain times from 12th April 2022 until the 14th April 2022 every night 9:00 PM to 5:30 AM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to

4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:

time be indicated by traffic signs.

- (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
- (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- 5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Pimlico Road, Lower Sloane Street, Sloane Square, Cliveden Place, Eaton Square, Hobart Place to normal route of travel. For traffic wishing to access Lower Belgrave Street via Ebury Street, Eccleston Street, Eaton Square and Hobart Place to normal route of travel.
