ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A23 GLA ROAD (LONDON ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF CROYDON) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF STOPPING) ORDER 2022

- Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the abovenamed Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable bridge inspection works to take place at the A23 London Road.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
- (1) stopping on the A23 London Road between its junction with Roche
 - (2) stopping in the loading and park bays on Norbury Avenue close to its junction with the A23 London Road.

The Order will be effective between 2nd May 2022 and 4th May 2022 every night 10:00 PM to 5:00 AM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a polici constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
