ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A501 GLA ROAD (MARYLEBONE ROAD, CITY OF WESTMINSTER) (TEMPORARY BANNED TURN) ORDER 2022

- 1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the abovenamed Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable electrical street works to take place on Marylebone Road.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from turning left from Marylebone Road into Lisson Grove northbound. The Order will be effective at certain times between 9:00 PM on 3rd May 2022 until 5:00 AM and 4th May 2022 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- 4. The prohibition will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes; (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police
 - constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London
- 5. At such times as the prohibition is in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Marylebone Road eastbound, Harewood Avenue and Hayes Place to normal route of travel.
