## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A501 GLA ROAD (MARYLEBONE ROAD, CITY OF WESTMINSTER) (TEMPORARY BANNED TURN) ORDER 2022

- Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above-named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable Thames Water works to take place on a section of the A501 Marylebone Road.3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from turning right
- into the southern arm of Baker Street from the eastbound carriageway of Marylebone Road.

  The Order will be effective between 28th April 2022 and 30th April 2022 every night 10:00 PM to 6:00 AM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be
- indicated by traffic signs.

  4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
  - any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
     anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police
  - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a polic constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- At such times as the prohibitions are in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Park Crescent and Marylebone Road to normal route of travel.
