

LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH
AMENDMENTS TO PARKING PLACES AND WAITING
RESTRICTIONS IN MONTFORD PLACE

NOTE: This Notice is about the removal of 6.9 metres of shared use parking place on the west side of Montford Place, located 37 metres south of Kennington Lane and the installation of double yellow line "at any time" waiting restrictions. 39.2 metres of single yellow line will be upgraded on the east side, outside No. 20 Montford Place, to double yellow line "at any time" waiting restrictions.

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth on 18th May 2022 made the Lambeth (Kennington) (Parking Places) (No. 7) Order 2022 and the Lambeth (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Amendment No. 315) Order 2022, under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The Orders will come into force on 21st May 2022.

2. The general effect of the Orders will be, in Montford Place, to:-

(a) remove 6.9 metres of shared use parking place on the west side located 37.4 metres south of the southern kerb-line of Kennington Lane and replace this section with double yellow line "at any time" waiting and restrictions; and

(b) upgrade 39.2 metres of single yellow line waiting restrictions on the east side, outside No. 20 Montford Place, to double yellow line "at any time" waiting restrictions.

3. The Orders are necessary to accommodate a new vehicle crossover on the west side of Montford Place as part of the development of "Oval Village" and prevent obstruction of access and disabled parking bays on the east side of Montford Place associated with No. 20 Montford Place.

6. If any person wishes to question the validity of the Orders or of any of their provisions on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under that Act has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Orders are made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
