ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS – ROUPELL STREET

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable service connection works to be carried out by Thames Water, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Roupell Street which lies between the party wall of Nos. 30 and 31 Roupell Street and the party wall of Nos. 33 and 34 Roupell Street.
2. The one-way system in Roupell Street between Theed Street and Cornwall Road would be suspended, so as to allow vehicles access and egress to properties and premises, providing that vehicle does not interfere with or disrupt the works.
3. The above road closure and suspensions would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing and covering of the appropriate traffic signs.
4. An alternative route for affected vehicles would be available via Hatfields, Stamford Street and Cornwall Road.
5. The Order would come into force on 6th June 2022 and it would continue for a maximum duration of 6 months or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the Order would only have effect from 6th June until 10th June 2022, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time then the Order may have effect on subsequent days within the maximum duration of 6 months.
