### **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

#### **TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS – VIRGIL STREET**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable sewer cleaning and maintenance works to be carried out by Thames Water, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering in the entire length of Virgil Street.
2. The above road closure would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
3. The alternative routes for affected vehicles would be via (a) Hercules Road, Cosser Street, Kennington Road, Lambeth Road, Hercules Road and Carlisle Lane; and (b) Carlisle Lane, Centaur Street and Hercules Road.
4. The Order would come into force on 9th June 2022 and it would continue for a maximum duration of 1 month or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the Order would only have effect from between 9.30am and 3.30pm, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time then the Order may have effect on subsequent days within the maximum duration of 1 month.
