

## **LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH**

### **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS WYVIL ROAD**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable works involving a crane operation to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Wyvil Road which lies between the western kerb-line of Luscombe Way and a point 30 metres south-west of that kerb-line.

2. The alternative routes for affected vehicles would be via:  
(a) Wandsworth Road, Landsdowne Way and South Lambeth Road; and (b) South Lambeth Road, Parry Street and Wandsworth Road.

3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order would come into force on 4th June 2022 and would continue for a maximum duration of 2 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the works would be carried out between 4th June 2022 and 5th June 2022 but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during this time then the Order may have effect at a subsequent time within the maximum period of 2 months.
