- delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) by vehicles in that length of Farquhar Road which lies between a point 20 metres north of the northern kerb-line of the northern arm of Jasper Road and a point 20 metres south-west of the southwestern kerb-line of the southern arm of Jasper Road:
- (c) impose a one-way traffic system in that length of the east to north-west and then south-west to north-east arms of Jasper Road, which lies between the southwestern kerb-line of the southern arm of Farquahar Road and the northern kerb-line of the northern arm of Farquahar Road, in a north-westerly and then north-easterly direction. 2. The restrictions are necessary because of the likelihood
