## LONDON BOROUGH OF LEWISHAM Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

## The Lewisham (Baring Road and Harland Road, SE12) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2022

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lewisham Council made this temporary traffic order under the provisions of section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because of Thames Water works on and adjacent to the highway. The effects of the order are indicated below. (1) One way northbound and no parking/waiting in Baring Road, SE12

- between the southern kerbline of St. Mildred's Road and appoint 50 metres southwards thereof. (2) Road closure and no parking/waiting in Harland Road, SE12 between Baring Road and Nos. 3/5 Harland Road. (3) The diversion routes for traffic affected by the prohibitions are via (i) St. Mildred's Road, Verdant Lane, Downham Way and Baring Road and (ii) Baring Road, Burnt Ash Hill, Coopers Lane and Baring Road; and (iii) Baring Road, Farmcote Road and Harland Road, and vice versa. (4) HGV diversion routes shall be via A205, A21 Downham Way and Bing Road. 2. No parking/waiting in (i) Baring Road between Nos. 35/37 and 63/65
- Baring Road: and (ii) Waite Davis Road, between Baring Road and Nos. 9/11 Waite Davies Road.
- Exemption is provided in the order for vehicles engaged on the works. vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform
- 4. The order comes into force on the 14th July 2022 to remain in force for 5 months or until the works are complete, whichever is the sooner. (Note: Works are expected to be completed by the end of October)
- The prohibitions apply as, when and to the extent signed on the highway.
