ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A23 GLA ROAD (BRIGHTON ROAD , LONDON BOROUGH OF CROYDON) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2022

- I. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- The purpose of the Order is to enable highway improvement and resurfacing works to take place on the A23 Brighton Road/ Farthing Way.
 The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from entering,

exiting, stopping or proceeding in either direction on A23 Brighton Road

- between the circulatory traffic system at the junction of the A32 Brighton Road, A237 Brighton Road and A23 Farthing Way and its junction with Woodfield Hill. Works will be phased such that both carriageways will not be closed at same time.

 The Order will be effective at certain times between 11th July 2022 and 11th January 2023, every night 9:00 PM until 5:00 AM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions
- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:(1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;

will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time

- (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- 5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs. Northbound via Brighton Road, M23, M25, A217 Brighton Road, Bolters Lane, Winkworth Road, Croydon Lane, Woodmansterne Lane, Little Woodcote Lane, Foxley Lane and Russell Hill Road to normal route of travel. Southbound via Farthing Way,

Brighton Road, Purley Road, Godstone Road, Caterham Bypass, Godstone Hill. M25 and M23 to normal route of travel.
