ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A3220 GLA ROAD (EARLS COURT ROAD/ REDCLIFFE GARDENS, ROYAL BOROUGH OF KENSINGTON AND CHELSEA) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2022

- 1. Transport for London in consultation with the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above-named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic
- Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3. 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable highway improvement and
- resurfacing works to take place on the A3220 Earls Court Road/ Redcliffe Gardens.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from: (I) entering or proceeding on Earls Court Road between its junctions
 - with Cromwell Road and Brompton Road, local access will be
 - maintained between Cromwell Road and No.304 Earls Court Road; (2) stopping on Earls Court Road between its junctions with Bramham
 - Gardens and Brompton Road: (3) entering or proceeding on Redcliffe Gardens between its junctions

access will be maintained between Warwick Road/ Finborough Road

Brompton Road and Redcliffe Street; (5) entering or proceeding on Old Brompton Road between its junctions with Warwick Road/ Finborough Road and Onslow Gardens, local

(4) stopping on Redcliffe Gardens between its junctions with Old

with Old Brompton Road and Redcliffe Street;

- and Coleherne Road and between Onslow Gardens and The Little **Boltons:**
- (6) stopping on Old Brompton Road between its junctions with Coleherne Road and The Little Boltons.
- Works will be phased such that some restrictions will apply only at certain times.
- The Order will be effective at certain times between 7th July 2022 and 31st January 2023 every night 9:00 PM to 5:00 AM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to
- time be indicated by traffic signs. 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for
- London. 5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force alternative routes will be
- indicated by traffic signs. For closure of Redcliffe Gardens via Old Brompton Road (eastbound), Onslow Square, Sydney Place and Fulham Road to normal route of travel. For closure of Earls Court Road/Old Brompton Road eastbound via Warwick Road, West Cromwell Road, Cromwell Road, Cromwell Gardens, Thurloe Place, Brompton Road, Knightsbridge, Hyde Park Corner, Knightsbridge, A4 Brompton Road, Brompton Road and Fulham Road to normal route of travel. For closure of Earls Court Road/Old Brompton Road westbound via West Cromwell

Road, Warwick Road, Kensington High Street, Queen's Gate, Onslow Gardens, Selwood Terrace and Fulham Road to normal route of travel.
