ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS – ABERFOYLE ROAD AND LEONARD ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable SGN to carry out gas main replacement works, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering or waiting (including waiting for the purpose of loading or unloading a vehicle) in the following lengths of roads:-

(a) that length of Aberfoyle Road which lies between Canforth Road and Streatham Vale;

(b) the entire length of Leonard Road.

2. The ban will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs. It is anticipated that works will be carried out in phases: (a) **Aberfoyle Road** – Phase 1 (18 July 2022 – 8 August 2022): outside 2 Aberfoyle Road and 30 Aberfoyle Road (north-eastern side of the carriageway); Phase 2 (9 August 2022 – 16 September 2022): outside 1 Aberfoyle Road and 27 Aberfoyle Road (south-western side of the carriageway); and (b) **Leonard Road** – Phase 1 (18 July 2022 – 15 August 2022): outside 15 Leonard Road and 67 Leonard Road (south-eastern side of the carriageway); Phase 2 (18 August 2022 and: outside 2 Leonard Road and 54 Leonard Road (north-western side of the carriageway).

3. The Order will come into force on 18th July 2022 for a maximum duration of 6 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. If the works cannot be carried out during the anticipated dates specified in paragraph 2 above, then the Order may have effect at a subsequent time within the maximum period of 6 months.
