

## **LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH**

### **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS – CHEVIOT ROAD**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable sewer connection works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering in that length of Cheviot Road which lies between party wall of Nos. 30 and 32 Cheviot Road and the party wall of Nos. 5 and 7 Cheviot Road.

2. The alternative route for affected vehicles would be via Knights Hill, Bewlys Road and Roxburgh Road and vice versa.

3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order would come into force on 25th July 2022 for a maximum duration of 2 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the works would be completed within 6 days, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during this time then the Order may have effect at a subsequent time within the maximum period of 2 months.
