PROPOSED CHANGES TO THE SCHOOL KEEP CLEAR MARKINGS, PARKING PLACES AND WAITING RESTRICTIONS – MANDRELL ROAD

(NOTE: This Notice is about proposals to remove the existing school keep clear marking in Mandrell Road opposite Nos. 18 to 28 Mandrell Road and extend the adjacent residents' parking place and install new school keep clear markings and a single yellow outside the new school entrance further along the road opposite Nos. 2 to 8 Mandrell Road, reduce the adjacent shared use residents' and business and pay by phone parking place and also to remove a length of residents' parking place outside Nos. 2 to 18 Mandrell Road and replace it with a single yellow line and extend the remaining residents' parking place so that the bay lies outside Nos. 8 to 28 Mandrell Road. Objections may be made – see paragraph 6.)

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth propose to make the Lambeth (Brixton "E") (Parking Places) (No. -) Order 202*, the Lambeth (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Amendment No. -) Order 202* and the Lambeth (Prohibition of Stopping Outside Schools) (Amendment No. -) Order 202*, under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

2. The general effect of the Orders would be:-

(a) on the south side to:

- (i) remove the school keep clear marking in Mandrell Road opposite Nos. 18 to 28 Mandrell Road and extend the existing adjacent residents' parking space by 25.56 metres;
- (ii) reduce a length of shared use pay by phone, residents' and business parking space and adjacent residents' only parking at the side of No. 4 Ashby Mews and opposite Nos. 2 to 8 Mandrell Road and install a new school keep clear marking and single yellow line which would operate outside the hours of the school keep clear marking in that length of road instead;

(b) on the north side to:

- (i) remove a length of residents' parking place outside Nos. 2 to 18 Mandrell Road and replace it with a single yellow line which would operate during zone hours at this location instead; and
- (ii) extend the existing residents' parking place by 25.4 metres in an eastward direction (outside Nos. 18 to 28 Mandrell Road).

3. The proposed Orders are required to enable the removal of an existing school keep clear marking in Mandrell Road which is no longer required and the extension of the adjacent residents' parking space. Changes to other parking places would enable the installation of a new school keep clear marking in Mandrell Road, the construction of a new dropped kerb so as to allow access to the newly renovated and developed school site and the installation of a single yellow line to prevent parking that might otherwise cause an obstruction.
