

LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS –
MEPHAM STREET

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable Network Rail to carry out repair and maintenance works, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, subject to the agreement of Transport for London, intends to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban pedestrians from entering the following lengths of Mepham Street:-

- (a) that length which lies between York Road and Waterloo Road;
- (b) that length of the bus road which lies under the viaduct, provided that the ban will not affect pedestrian access to premises as directed by a traffic marshall.

2. The alternative route for pedestrians would be available via Waterloo Road, Tenison Way and York Road and vice versa.

3. The bans would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order would come into force on 12th August 2022 for a maximum duration of 6 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the works would be carried out in phases and completed within 25 days, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during this time then the Order may have effect at a subsequent time within the maximum period of 6 months.
