The alternative route for affected cyclists will be via: (a) Regent Road, Dulwich Road and Hurst Street; or (b) Rymer Street, Dulwich Road and Regent Road, 3. The ban will only apply at such times and to such extent

as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order will come into force on 16th July 2022 for a maximum duration of 1 month or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the works will be completed within 2 days, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during this time then the Order may have effect at a subsequent
