ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS – RAILTON
ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable crane operation works to be carried out by Southern Cranes & Access, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intends to make an Order the effect of which would be to ban vehicles, including pedal cycles and buses, from entering in that length of Railton Road which lies between the party wall of Nos. 243 and 245 Railton Road and a point 10 metres north of the northern property boundary of No. 241a Railton Road.

2. The alternative route for affected cyclists would be via: (a) Regent Road, Dulwich Road and Hurst Street; or (b) Rymer Street, Dulwich Road and Regent Road.

3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order would come into force on 16th July 2022 for a maximum duration of 1 month or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the works would be completed within 2 days, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during this time then the Order may have effect at a subsequent time within the maximum period of 1 month.
