2. The alternative route for affected vehicles would be via:

(a) Knights Hill, Wolfington Road and Casewick Road and (b) Casewick Road and Thornlaw Road. 3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such

extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order would come into force on 25th July 2022 for a maximum duration of 6 months or until the works have

4. The Order would come into force on 25th July 2022 for a maximum duration of 6 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the works would be completed between 25th July 2022 and 5th August 2022, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during this time then the Order may have effect at a subsequent time within the maximum period of 6 months.
