ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS –
THORNTON STREET

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable telecommunication works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, subject to the agreement of Transport for London, intends to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban pedestrians and vehicles from entering in that length of Thornton Street between Brixton Road and the eastern kerb-line of the vehicular entrance to the rear of Nos. 300 to 302 Brixton Road.

2. The alternative route for pedestrians and vehicles would be available via Brixton Road and Robsart Street.

3. The bans would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order would come into force on 11th August 2022 for a maximum duration of 1 month or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the works would be completed within 1 day but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during this time then the Order may have effect at a subsequent time within the maximum period of 1 month.
