

LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS –
WANDSWORTH ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable works involving a crane operation to be carried out safely, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, subject to the agreement of Transport for London, intends to make an Order the effect of which would be to:-

- (a) ban vehicles from entering in that length of Wandsworth Road, which lies between the northern property boundary of No. 101 Wandsworth Road and the south-western kerb-line of Nine Elms Lane and south-eastern kerb-line of Parry Street;
- (b) ban pedestrians from entering the western footway of the length of Wandsworth Road specified in subparagraph 1(a) above.

2. The alternative route for affected vehicles would be via:

- (a) Lavender Hill, Queenstown Road, Queens Circus, Prince of Wales Drive, Battersea Park Road and Nine Elms Lane; and
- (b) Nine Elms Lane, Battersea Park Road and Queenstown Road.

3. The alternative route for pedestrians and dismounted pedal cyclists would be via the eastern footway.

4. The bans would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

5. The Order would come into force on 22nd July 2022 for a maximum duration of 6 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the crane operation works would be carried out between the following dates – (a) between 22nd July 2022 and 24th July 2022; (b) between 20th August 2022 and 21st August 2022; and (c) 10th September 2022 and 11th September 2022. If the works cannot be carried out or completed during these times, then the Order may have effect at a subsequent time within the maximum period of 6 months.
