20MPH SPEED LIMIT – BROCKLEY ROAD &
LEWISHAM HIGH STREET

The Lewisham (20mph Speed Limit) Traffic Order 202*

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lewisham Borough Council propose to make the above Order under section 84 of Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
2. The general effect of the Order would be to introduce a 20mph speed limit in:
 - (a) the length of Brockley Road which lies south of Harefield Road; and
 - (b) the length of Lewisham High Street which lies between Rennell Street and Station Road.
3. The introduction of a 20mph speed limit in the lengths of roads referred to in paragraph 2 above is to ensure consistency with the existing boroughwide 20mph speed limit that applies throughout Lewisham, except for roads on the Transport for London Road Network (TLRN). Speed Limit Orders on the TLRN (“red routes”) are made by Transport for London.
4. A copy of the proposed Order and other documents giving more detailed particulars of the Order are available for inspection between 9 am and 5 pm on Monday to Friday at the reception of the Council’s office, Laurence House, 1 Catford Road, London, SE6 4RU. Alternatively, the documents can be obtained by emailing a request to trafficorders@lewisham.gov.uk quoting reference “20mph Speed Limit”.
5. Any objection or other representations relating to the proposed Order must be made in writing and all objections must specify the grounds on which they are made and emailed to: trafficorders@lewisham.gov.uk or posted to Lewisham Transport Policy & Development, Fifth Floor Laurence House, 1 Catford Road, London SE6 4RU, quoting reference “20mph Speed Limit” to arrive not later than 21 days from the date of publication of this notice. Any objection may be communicated to other persons who may be affected.
