ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A3204 GLA ROAD (KENNINGTON LANE, LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2022

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above-named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable highway improvement and resurfacing works to take place on the A3204 Kennington Lane.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 - (1) entering, exiting, proceeding or stopping on Kennington Lane eastbound between its junctions with Tyers Street and Cardigan Street;
 - (2) entering, exiting or proceeding on Kennington Lane westbound between its junctions with Kennington Road and Oval Way;
 - (3) stop in the Loading, Unloading and Disabled Persons' Vehicles Bay on Montford Place at the Side of No. 247 Kennington Lane.The Order will be effective between the dates of 3rd July 2022 and 25th July 2022, every Sunday at 9:30 PM until Monday at 5:00 AM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.

At such times as the prohibitions are in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs: **For eastbound traffic** via Durham Street, Harleyford Road, Kennington Oval, Harleyford Road, Kennington Park Road and Kennington Road to normal route of travel. **For westbound traffic** via Kennington Road, Kennington Park Road, Harleyford Street, Kennington Oval, Harleyford Road and Kennington Lane to normal route of travel. **For westbound traffic from Cardigan Street** via Kennington Road, Chester Way, Kennington Lane, Kennington Road, Kennington Park Road, Harleyford Road, Kennington Oval and Harleyford Road to normal route of travel. **For vehicles travelling to Vauxhall Street & Loughborough Street** via Kennington Road, Black Prince Road and Newburn Street to normal route of travel. **For vehicles travelling to Courtenay Street** via Kennington Road, Sancroft Street, Cardigan Street and Cardigan Square to normal route of travel.
