ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A205 GLA ROAD (WESTHORNE AVENUE, ROYAL BOROUGH OF GREENWICH AND LONDON BOROUGH OF LEWISHAM) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC, STOPPING AND 20 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2022

- I. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- The purpose of the Order is to enable water main repair works to take place on the A205 Westhorne Avenue.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 - (1) turning right from Westhorne Avenue eastbound into Alnwick Road; (2) turning right from Alnwick Road into Westhorne Avenue eastbound;
 - (3) stopping on Westhorne Avenue between its junctions with Alnwick Road and Horn Park Lane;
 - (4) exceeding 20 MPH on Westhorne Avenue westbound between its junction with Horn Park Lane and a point 80 metres west of its junction Woodyates Road;
 - (5) exceeding 20 MPH on Westhorne Avenue eastbound between a point 40 metres west of its junction Woodyates Road and Nos. 284 – 286 Westhorne Avenue.

The Order will be effective at certain times between 12:01 AM on 23 rd July 2022 and 10:00 PM on 2 nd October 2022 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- 5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs. For Alnwick Road via Westhorne Avenue eastbound, roundabout at Westhorne Avenue/ Sidcup Road and Westhorne Avenue westbound to normal route of travel. For Westhorne Avenue eastbound via Westhorne Ave westbound, Burnt Ash Hill, Burnt Ash Road, Eltham Road and Sidcup Road to normal route of travel.
