### **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

#### **TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS – KNOLLYS ROAD**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable repair and maintenance works to be carried out by Thames Water, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering in that length of Knollys Road which lies between the north-eastern kerb-line of Leigham Vale and the roundabout at the junction of Leigham Vale and Knollys Road.
2. The alternative routes for vehicles will be via York Hill, Royal Circus, Pymont Grove, Canterbury Grove and Leigham Court Road and vice versa; or (b) Leigham vale, Stockfield Road, Rosedene Avenue and Leigham Court Road and vice versa.
3. The ban will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
4. The Order will come into force on 22nd August 2022 for a maximum duration of 6 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the works will be completed within 15 days, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during this time then the Order may have effect at a subsequent time within the maximum period of 6 months.
