20MPH SPEED LIMIT – BROCKLEY ROAD &
LEWISHAM HIGH STREET

The Lewisham (20mph Speed Limit) (No. 1) Traffic Order
2022

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lewisham Borough Council on 22nd August 2022 made the above Order under section 84 of Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
2. The general effect of the Order will be to introduce a 20mph speed limit in:
 - (a) the length of Brockley Road which lies south of Harefield Road; and
 - (b) the length of Lewisham High Street which lies between Rennell Street and Station Road.
3. The introduction of a 20mph speed limit in the lengths of roads referred to in paragraph 2 above is to ensure consistency with the existing boroughwide 20mph speed limit that applies throughout Lewisham, except for roads on the Transport for London Road Network (TLRN). Speed Limit Orders on the TLRN (“red routes”) are made by Transport for London.
4. Copies of the made Order, which will come into force on 30th August 2022, and other documents giving more detailed particulars of the Order and its effect may be obtained by emailing a request to trafficorders@lewisham.gov.uk quoting reference “20mph Speed Limit TMO”, or collected for inspection between 9 am and 5 pm on Monday to Friday at the reception of the Council’s office, Laurence House, 1 Catford Road, London, SE6 4RU.
5. If any person wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under that Act has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Order was made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
