The effects of the Order are indicated below. 1. (1) Road closure and no parking/waiting in (i) Endwell Road between the common boundaries of Nos. 25/27 and 37/39 Endwell Road: and

eastwards thereof. (2) The diversion routes for traffic affected by the prohibitions are via (i) Endwell Road, Shardeloes Road, Vesta Road and Endwell Road, and vice versa; and (ii) Lewisham Road, Lewisham Hill. Walerand, Eliot Park and Granville Park and vice versa.

(ii) Granville Park, SE13 between Lewisham Road and a point 30 meters

- 2. Suspension of the one way working in Endwell Road during the works (to allow resident access and egress)
- 3. Exemption is provided in the Order for vehicles engaged on the works, vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform.
- 4. The Order comes into force on the 5th October 2022 to remain in
- force for up to 2 months. The prohibitions apply as, when and to the extent signed on the highway.
