NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lewisham Council made the above named temporary traffic order under the provisions of section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because of works on and adjacent to the highway. The effects of the order are indicated below

LONDON BOROUGH OF LEWISHAM

- (1) Road closure and no parking/waiting in (i) Shroffold Road, western arm, between Northover and the projected western boundary of No.87 Northover: (ii) Lincombe Road, between Northover and the projected common boundary of Nos.2 & 4 Lincombe Road; (iii) Shaw Road, from Northover to the projected rear boundary of 101 Northover; and (iv) Whitefoot Terrace, between Northover and the projected western boundary of 101 Northover, (2) The alternative routes for traffic affected by the prohibitions are via (i) Northover, Shaw Boad, Woodbank Boad and Shroffold Road, and vice versa: (ii) Northover, Whitefoot Terrace, Woodbank Road and Lincombe Road, and vice versa; (iii) Northover, Lincombe Road, Woodbank Road and Shaw Road, and vice versa; (iv) Verdant Lane. Whitefoot Lane and Whitefoot Terrace, and vice versa, or Northover, Lincombe Road, Woodbank Road and Whitefoot Terrace, and vice versa. No parking/waiting in (i) Northover, between Durham Hill and Verdant
- Lane; and (ii) Verdant Lane, between Northover and Downham Way. 3. Exemption is provided in the order for vehicles officially engaged on the events, vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer.
- The order comes into force on the 30th August 2022 to remain in force for up to 3 months.
- 5. The prohibitions apply as, when and to the extent signed on the highway.
