ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A23 GLA SIDE ROAD (ACRE LANE, LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH) (TEMPORARY BANNED TURN) ORDER 2022

- Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable electrical connection works to take place on Brixton Road.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle over 7.5 tonnes from turning left from Acre Lane into Brixton Road northbound.

 The Order will be effective at certain times between 10:00 AM on 22nd August 2022 and 5:30 PM on 14th September 2022 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- 4. The prohibition will not apply in respect of:
 - any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police
 - constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
