ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A3220 GLA ROAD (ADDISON CRESCENT, ROYAL BOROUGH OF KENSINGTON AND CHELSEA) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF STOPPING) ORDER 2022

1. Transport for London in consultation with the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable water connection works to take place on the A3220 Addison Crescent.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from stopping on Addison Crescent between its junctions with Holland Road and Addison Road.

The Order will be effective between 17th September 2022 and 25th September 2022, every Saturday at 8:00 AM until Sunday at 5:00 AM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
