ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE FERNDALE ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable Network Rail bridge examination works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth have made an Order, the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that section of Ferndale Road (west to east arm) which lies between the southern kerb-line Pulross Road and a point 10 metres south-west of the railway bridge, located adjacent to No. 234a Ferndale Road.

2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles will not be required.

3. The ban will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order will come into force on 28th September 2022 and will continue for a maximum duration of 18 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the Order will only remain in force for up to 2 months.
