ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE GLENELDON MEWS

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable electricity repair and maintenance works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, with the agreement of Transport for London, have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles and pedestrians from entering that section of Gleneldon Mews, which lies between the party wall of Nos. 197 and 199 Streatham High Road and the party wall of Nos. 201 and 203 Streatham High Road.

2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles will be available via Gleneldon Road, Bournevale Road, Stanthorpe Road and Ashlake Road.

3. The ban will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order will come into force on 5th September 2022 and will continue for a maximum duration of 18 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the Order will only have effect between 5th September 2022 and the 5th March 2023, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time the order will also have effect on subsequent dates.
