ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE NEALDEN STREET

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable street pole replacement works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that section of Nealden Street which lies between the common boundary of Nos. 29 and 30 Nealden Street and the common boundary of Nos. 33 and 34 Nealden Street.

2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles willd be provided via Landor Road, Hargwyne Street, Combermere Road and vice versa.

3. The ban will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order will come into force on 22nd September 2022 and will continue for a maximum duration of 18 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the Order will only have effect between 22nd September 2022 and the 22nd November 2022, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time the Order will also have effect on subsequent dates.
