replacement works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, intend to make an order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that section of Nealden Street which lies between

and the common boundary of Nos. 33 and 34 Nealden Street.

2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be provided via Landor Road, Hargwyne Street, Combermere

the common boundary of Nos. 29 and 30 Nealden Street

Road and vice versa.

3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order would come into force on 22nd September.

4. The Order would come into force on 22nd September 2022 and would continue for a maximum duration of 18 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the Order would only have effect between 22nd September 2022 and the 22nd November 2022, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that

time the order would also have effect on subsequent dates.
