

LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14
TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE UPPER GROUND

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable crane operation works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, with the agreement of Transport for London and the London Borough of Southwark, intend to make an order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles and pedestrians from entering that section of Upper Ground, including the north-western footway, which lies between the north-eastern kerb-line of Cornwall Road and the south-western kerb-line of Coin Street.

2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via Broadwall, Stamford Street, Waterloo Road, Belvedere Road, Cornwall Road, Hatfields and Upper Ground.

3. Alternative routes for affected pedestrians will be available via the south-eastern footway of Upper Ground.

4. The bans would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

5. The Order would come into force on 11th September 2022 and would continue for a maximum duration of 18 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the Order would only have effect between 11th September 2022 and the 11th March 2023, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time the order would also have effect on subsequent dates.
