

LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14
TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE VAUXHALL WALK

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable crane operation works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, with the agreement of Transport for London, intend to make an order the effect of which would be to temporarily:

- (a) ban vehicles and pedestrians from entering that section of Vauxhall Walk, including the western footway, which lies between the southern kerb-line of Tinworth Street and the northern kerb-line of the access road leading to the residential car park behind Kennedy House; and
- (b) suspend the one-way working in Vauxhall Walk so that traffic would be permitted to travel in two directions.

2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via Gleneldon Road, Bournevale Road, Stanthorpe Road, Ashlake Road and an alternative route for affected pedestrians would be available via the eastern footway

3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order would come into force on 16th September 2022 and would continue for a maximum duration of 18 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the Order would only have effect between 16th September 2022 and the 16th March 2023, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time the order would also have effect on subsequent dates.
