ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE WHITGIFT STREET

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable new service connection works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that section of Whitgift Street which lies between the western kerb-line of Newport Street and a point 15 metres north-west of that kerb-line.

2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles will be available via Lambeth High Street, Black Prince Road, Newport Street and vice versa.

3. The ban will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order will come into force on 26th September 2022 and will continue for a maximum duration of 18 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the Order will only remain in force for up to 6 months.

Please note that the original date for the Order coming into force of 16th September 2022, as advertised on 9th September 2022, has been postponed due to the passing of Her Majesty The Queen.
