TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE WYVIL ROAD 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable crane operation works to be carried out, the Council of the

London Borough of Lambeth, with the agreement of Transport for London, have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that section of Wyvil Road which lies between the eastern boundary of No. 1 Wyvil Road and the western kerb-line of

Luscombe Way. Alternative routes for affected vehicles will be available via Wandsworth Road, Lansdowne Way, South Lambeth Road, Parry Street and Wyvil Road.

The ban will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs. 4. The Order will come into force on 24th September 2022

and will continue for a maximum duration of 18 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the Order will only remain in force for up to 6 months.

Please note that the original date for the Order coming into force of 17th September 2022, as advertised on 9th

September 2022, has been postponed due to the passing of Her Majesty The Queen.
