ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE WYVIL ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable crane operation works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, with the agreement of Transport for London, intend to make an order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that section of Wyvil Road which lies between the eastern boundary of No. 1 Wyvil Road and the western kerb-line of Luscombe Way.

2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via Wandsworth Road, Lansdowne Way, South Lambeth Road, Parry Street and Wyvil Road.

3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order would come into force on 17th September 2022 and would continue for a maximum duration of 18 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the Order would only have effect between 17th September 2022 and the 17th March 2023, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time the order would also have effect on subsequent dates.
