Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

**The Lewisham (Ardfillan Road, SE6, St. Asaph Road, SE4
and Breakspears Road, SE4)**

(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2022

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lewisham Council made the above named temporary traffic order under the provisions of section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because of works on and adjacent to the highway. The effects of the order are indicated below.

1. (1) Road closure and no parking/waiting in (i) Ardfillan Road, SE6 between the northern kerbline of Ardoch Road and the projected common boundary of Nos. 58/60 Ardfillan Road; (ii) St. Asaph Road, SE4 between the projected common boundaries of Nos. 48/50 and Nos. 60/62 St Asaph Road; and (iii) Breakspears Road, SE4 between Harefield Road and the projected common boundary of Nos.88/90 Breakspears Road. (2) The alternative routes for traffic affected by the prohibition are via (i) Ardoch Road, Torridon Road or Birkhall Road, Dowanhill Road and Ardfillan Road, and vice versa; (ii) St. Asaph Road, Avignon Road, Friendsbury Road, St. Norbert Road, Brockley Way, Merttins Road, Ivydale Road, Cheltenham Road, Peckham Rye, Nunhead Lane, Linden Grove and St. Asaph Road, and vice versa, and (iii) Harefield Road, Wickham Road, Glensdale Road and Breakspears Road, and vice versa.

2. Exemption is provided in the order for vehicles engaged on the works, vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer.

3. The order comes into force on the 19th September 2022 to remain in force for up to 2 months.

4. The prohibitions apply as, when and to the extent signed on the highway.
