The Lewisham (Charged-For Parking Places) (Amendment No. 54) Order 2022

The Lewisham (Free Parking Places, Loading Places and Waiting Loading and Stopping Restrictions) (Amendment No. 50) Order 2022

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lewisham Borough Council on 31st August 2022 made the above-mentioned Orders under the powers of sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
2. The general effect of the Orders, which will come into force on 5th September 2022, will be to remove the single yellow line waiting restrictions measuring approximately three metres in length from outside No. 47 Brockley Rise. The Council intends to extend the adjacent bus stop to replace the single yellow line.
3. Documents giving more detailed particulars of the Orders can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays at the office of Lewisham Transport Policy & Development, 4th Floor Laurence House, 1 Catford Road, London SE6 4RU.
4. If any person wishes to question the validity of the Orders or of any of their provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under that Act has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Order were made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
