The Lewisham (Farmfield Rd, Glenbow Rd & Sandpit Rd, BR1)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2022

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lewisham Council intend to make the

above named temporary traffic order under the provisions of section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because of works on and adjacent to the highway. The effects of the order will be as indicated below.

1. (1) Road closure and no parking/waiting in (ii) Farmfield Road, between

the common boundary of Nos. 34 & 36 Farmfield Road and the western kerbline of Glenbow Road; (ii) Glenbow Road, between the northern kerbline of Farmfield Road and a point 90 meters northwards thereof; and (iii) Sandpit Road, between the southern kerbline of Farmfield Road and common boundary of Nos. 65 & 67. (2) The alternative routes for traffic affected by the prohibitions shall be via a combination of Bromley Road, Farmfield Road, Glenbow Road, Kendale Road, Rangefield Road, Sandpit Road and Valeswood Road, as works dictate.

2. The existing road closure to the south of 52 Glenbow Road shall

- be suspended during any closure of Glenbow Road as specified in article 1(ii) of this Notice.

 3. Exemption will be provided in the order for vehicles engaged on the works, vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes
- and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer.

 4. The order is intended to come into force on the 17th October 2022 to remain in force until 31st March 2023 or until the works are complete, whichever is the sooner. (Note: Works are planned to be completed by
- 28th January 2023.)

 5. The prohibitions will apply as, when and to the extent signed on the highway.
